Notes On Inverness Cycle Club and Membership Membership

Membership of the Inverness Cycle Club (ICC) is currently open to all cyclists over the age of 18 years from anywhere irrespective of ethnicity, nationality, sexuality, religion or beliefs, age, sex, or disability except as a necessary consequence of the requirements of cycling as a sport and as a necessary consequence of the resources of the Club.

Membership allows you to represent ICC in open events, and qualify for any club/regional/national championships. Members may also attend and vote at Club and regional meetings.

Membership Cost

Membership fees are required to secure annual affiliation to ICC's governing bodies.

The membership year runs from 1st January to 31st December. Membership can be bought at any time of year. Annual renewals will be accepted between Dec 1st and Feb 28th.

The annual fee for Membership is £15 for the full year. If a new member joins part way through the membership year the fee is reduced pro-rata, so from 1 March to 31 May the joining fee will be £11.25, from 1 June to 31 August £7.50, and from 1 September to 30 November £3.75. Existing members who fail to renew at the start of the year and choose to renew later in the year will have to pay for a full year's membership fee.

Insurance

Members participate in club activities at their own risk.

By Affiliating to British Cycling, the Inverness Cycle Club is insured against third party liability. The policy only indemnifies the club in respect of its legal liability for accidental loss or damage to third party property or accidental bodily injury or death to third party persons. It does not include personal accident cover, liability for accidents caused by club members, or damage to equipment.

Members of British Cycling can obtain varying levels of insurance depending on their membership, ranging from bike insurance up to personal accident insurance and more.

It is strongly advised that all members actively involved in cycling at any level obtain appropriate insurance such as that provided by British Cycling and that silver or ride membership be considered as a minimum.
